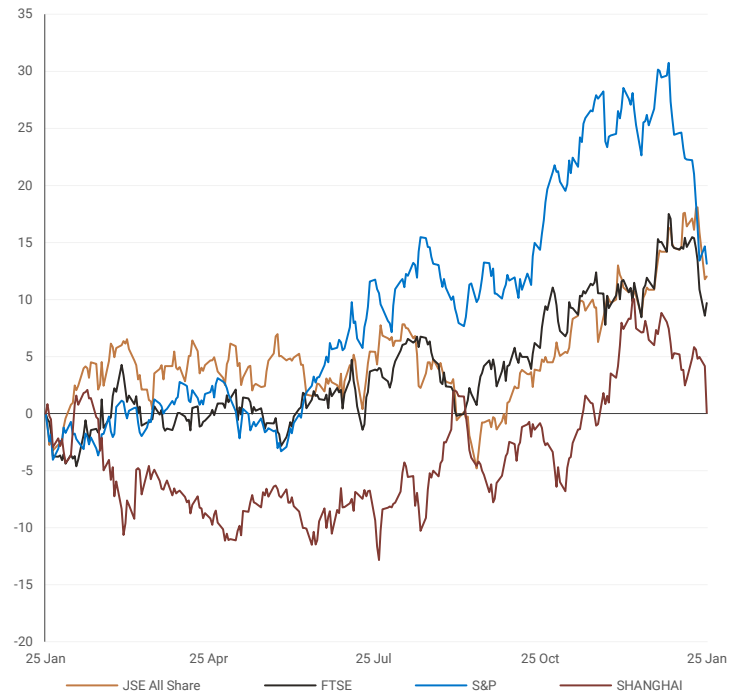

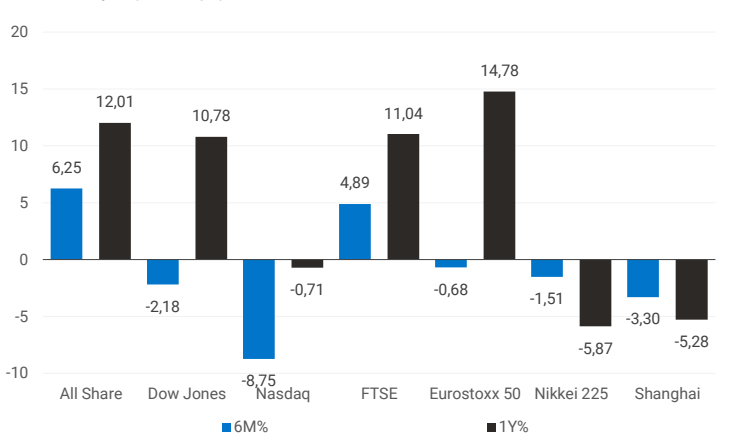

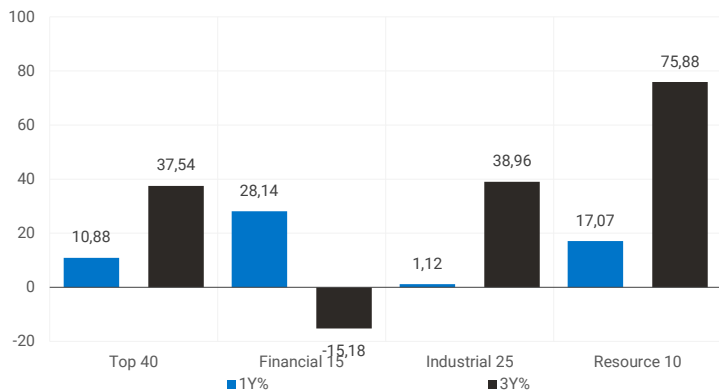
JSE TOP 40 INDEX

MOTUS HOLDINGS LIMITED – Further Trading Statement and Operational Update

Vehicle sales are continuing to recover despite the erratic vehicle supplies being experienced by Original Equipment Manufacturers (OEMs). In South Africa, The Automotive Business Council for South Africa (naamsa) reported annual aggregate industry sales for new vehicle sales to be 464 122 vehicles for the 12 months to 31 December 2021, compared to 380 206 vehicles in the comparative period, up by 22% for the calendar year. Management projects annual new vehicle sales to be between 470 000 and 490 000 vehicles for the financial year ending 30 June 2022, compared to 445 319 vehicles in the comparative period. Motus' increased market share to date has been supported by an expansion of its vehicle model range, particularly in the growing entry level and small to medium SUV categories, coupled with exciting new model launches. Strong demand for pre-owned vehicles across all geographies continues on the back of the shortage of new vehicles. Motus says it expects its headline earnings per share (Heps) for the half-year period to fall within 763 cents and 815 cents per share. The importers and distributors of vehicle brands like Hyundai, Kia and Mitsubishi motors, says it expects its operating profit for the reporting period to increase by between 20% and 26% to between R2.1 million and R2.2 million. The group will be releasing its interim financial results for the six months ended December 31, 2021 on Tuesday, February 22, 2022.

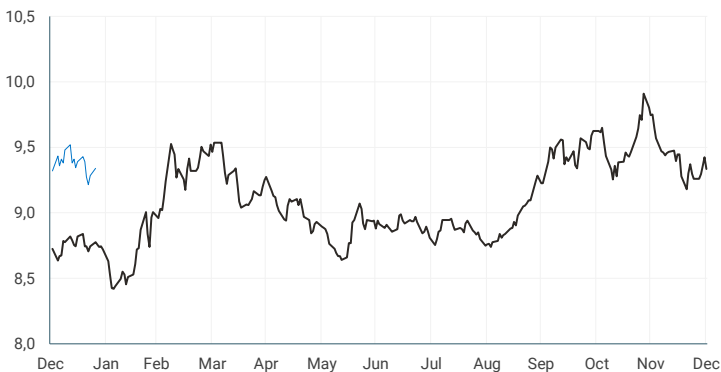

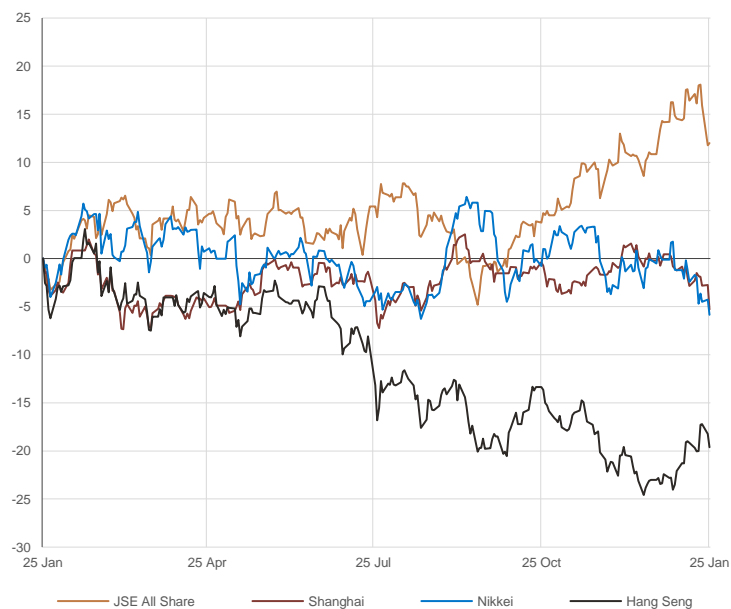

European stocks closed higher on Tuesday, recouping some losses from a sharp sell-off on Monday as investors sifted through a fresh batch of corporate earnings. The pan-European Stoxx 600 closed up around 0.8%, with banks adding 2.9% to lead gains as most sectors and major bourses finished in positive territory. Tech stocks, on the other hand, fell around 0.8%. In terms of individual share price movement, Ericsson gained almost 8% after beating fourth-quarter earnings expectations, with profits bolstered by high demand for 5G network equipment.

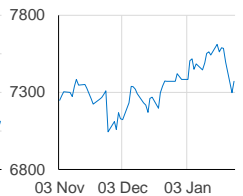

Banks and energy stocks, sectors that stand to benefit from a recovering economy and higher yields, led Tuesday's comeback. The yield on the benchmark 10-year Treasury note resumed its 2022 gain Tuesday to around 1.78%. Tech shares struggled amid rising rates.

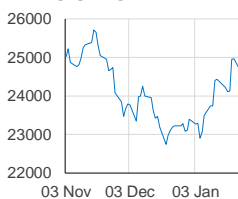

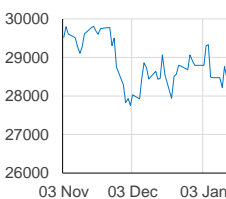

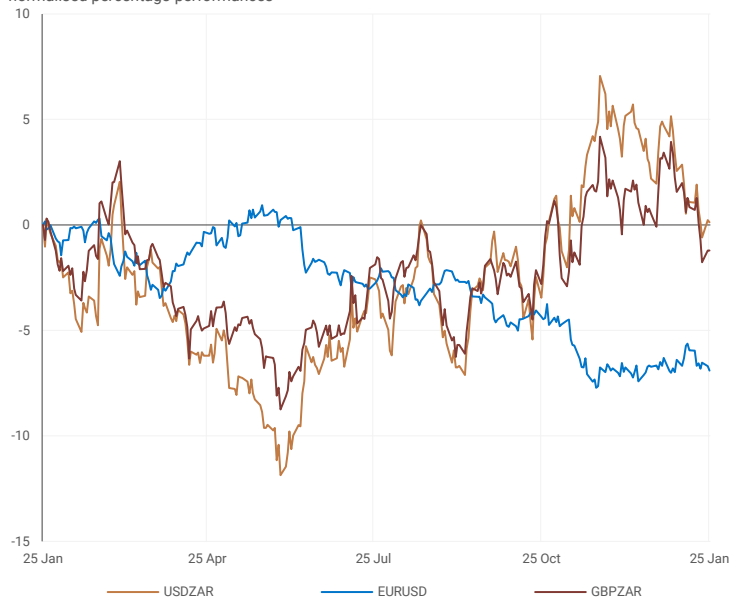
